Founded in 1909, Lanzhou University (LZU) is a national comprehensive research university located in Lanzhou, the capital city of Gansu Province. It is administered directly by central government. In 2017, LZU listed as one of the top universities in China under the "Double First-Class" Initiative.

Founded

The management discipline of LZU stems from the Banking and Accounting Training Class in the then National Gansu College in 1939. In 2004, considering the practical development need of management discipline, LZU decided to establish School of Management (LUSM), as a comprehensive school driven by disciplines of public administration and business administration.

Accredited

LUSM was initially accredited by AMBA in 2014, renewed in 2017. In 2022, the school was re-accredited by AMBA and awarded BGA accreditation initially for a combined



term of five years, making LUSM the first institution of higher education jointly accredited by both AMBA and BGA in Northwest China.

Accommodation	<p>Lanzhou University provides guaranteed double-room on-campus residence for exchange students, pre-assigned in the Guest House or Yuejin Building with private bathroom, public laundry room and kitchen.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Self-funded exchange students (30 RMB/day, 4500RMB/semester). Unless specifically waived based on the mutual agreement, the accommodation fee should be paid all by the students.➤ Accommodation-fee-waived exchange students (600RMB deposit only). Please contact your home university International Office for confirmation.
Campus Facilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Free Wi-Fi➤ Dining halls and Muslim canteen are located on the campus➤ Public laundry room is right beside the Muslim canteen

Visa Information & Residence permit	<p>You may hold X1 or X2 visa only to enter Chinese border, otherwise you will be responsible for all the possible consequences. Please also make sure that your passport is valid till the end of your study at LZU.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Students with X1 (000 day) visa should apply for residence permit within 30 days after arrival. Supporting documents will be provided by LZU after registration, including<ol style="list-style-type: none">(1) Application form for residence permit(2) Foreigner Physical exam form(3) The yellow copy of 202 form(4) Photocopy of passport(5) Recommendation letterIt costs approx. 400 RMB to apply for residence permit.➤ Students with X2 (120/150/180 days) visa may or may not need to apply for residence permit within 30 days after arrival, which depends on the exchange length. For one semester (about 5 months) exchange students, we suggest them to apply for X2 (150/180 days)visa.
Medical Insurance	<p>Exchange students must obtain health insurance for the entire length of their exchange. They must purchase the relevant insurance upon arrival at Lanzhou University (about 500RMB/semester).</p>
